

CONTACT TRACING and COMMUNICABLE DISEASE CONTROL



FACT: For years Public Health has conducted contract tracing to prevent the spread of communicable disease. Need examples? Tuberculosis (TB), HIV-AIDS, or Hepatitis A.

FACT: COVID-19 is highly contagious. There is no vaccine currently.

FACT: We (your Health Department) are notified when any person who resides in one of our counties has a lab positive result for COVID-19.

FACT: We are required to notify the infected individual to initiate self-monitoring and home isolation. We ask the identity of “close contacts” so we can contact and alert them to the exposure.

FACT: We NEVER ask for a Social Security number. We NEVER charge a fee. We NEVER ask for banking information. We NEVER reveal the identity of an infected individual. BEWARE OF COVID-19 SCAMS! Call your Health Department if you are unsure.

FACT: Contact Tracing stops the spread of infection to your family, co-workers, and friends! We help to monitor for potential complications. We provide guidance when it is safe to stop home isolation. We contact your employer for you!

FACT: Contact tracing gets you back to work – back with friends – back to your life.
