**North Central District Health Department regrettably announces the second death in Shelby County due to complications from the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). One additional lab-confirmed case in Shelby County, increasing the district case count to 36. Two individuals monitored by North Central District has been released from isolation.**

Shelby County, KY – Shelby has had its second COVID-19 related death in an elderly female with underlying medical conditions, our hearts and prayers go out to her family and friends.

One patient from Shelby County has tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19); the adult male is currently in self-isolation at home.

North Central District has released two Shelby County patients from isolation. Both individuals have been released from isolation by monitoring their symptoms and complying with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.

“Some people may confuse isolation with quarantine. Those who are in isolation are sick and infectious and should separate themselves from those who are not sick to include members in their household. Those who are in quarantine have been exposed to someone who is sick and need to separate themselves from others, so they do not infect others if they become sick.”, said Roanya Rice, Public Health Director of NCDHD
