North Central District Health Department has two new lab-confirmed cases, one in Shelby County and one in Henry County increasing the district case count to 38. Six individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.

Shelby County, KY – North Central District Health Department has two new cases that have tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). One adult male from Shelby County in self-isolation at home and the other is an adult male from Henry County under medical care.

North Central District has released six individuals from isolation. Four from Shelby County, one in Spencer County, and one in Trimble County have been released from isolation by monitoring their symptoms and complying with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.

“If you have symptoms and feel you need to be tested for COVID-19, you should reach out to your medical provider and get tested. Testing is a key component that is needed in order to start the reopening phases.”, said Roanya Rice, Public Health Director of NCDHD
