**North Central District Health Department is reporting a new lab-confirmed case in Spencer County, increasing the district case count to 40. One person monitored by North Central District has been released from isolation.**

Spencer County, KY – North Central District Health Department has a new case that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). An adult female from Spencer County in self-isolation at home.

North Central District has released one individual from isolation from Shelby County by monitoring their symptoms and complying with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.

“If you have symptoms and feel you need to be tested for COVID-19, you should reach out to your medical provider and get tested. Testing is a key component that is needed in order to start the reopening phases.”, said Roanya Rice, Public Health Director of NCDHD
