North Central District Health Department is reporting a new lab-confirmed case in Spencer County, increasing the district case count to 49. Three individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.

Shelby County, KY – North Central District Health Department has a new case that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). An adult male is from Spencer County who is in self-isolation at home.

North Central District released three individuals from isolation one Henry County and two from Shelby County by monitoring their symptoms and complying with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.

The case reported in Henry on April 27, 2020, was erroneously reported to the health department, and is not a case.

“As we work toward restarting the economy and getting back to the new normal, it will be important for those returning to work to wear a mask. This will help to prevent the further spread of the virus.”, said Roanya Rice, Public Health Director of NCDHD
