North Central District Health Department is reporting two new lab-confirmed cases in Spencer County, increasing the district case count to 51. One individual monitored by North Central District has been released from isolation.

Spencer County, KY – North Central District Health Department has two new cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). An adult male is from Spencer County and an adult female both are in self-isolation at home.

North Central District released one individual from isolation from Spencer County who monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.
