North Central District Health Department is reporting two new lab-confirmed cases one in Shelby County and one in Henry County, increasing the district case count to 53. One individual monitored by North Central District has been released from isolation.

Shelby County, KY – North Central District Health Department has two new cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). An adult male from Shelby County under medical care and an adult female from Henry County in self-isolation at home.

North Central District released one individual from isolation from Henry County who monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.

“NCDHD will start providing COVID-19 testing on Tuesday, 5/5. Testing is by appointment only. You can make an appointment by calling NCDHD’s Call Center at 502-390-2600. I would encourage those who need it to be tested. Testing is an important component to help us get back to the new normal.”, said Roanya Rice, Public Health Director of NCDHD
