North Central District Health Department regretfully announces one new death in Henry County due to complications from the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). Sixteen new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby, Henry, and Spencer Counties, increasing the district case count to 1137. Fifty-one individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.

Shelby County, KY – Henry County has had one new COVID-19 related death in an elderly male with underlying medical conditions; our hearts and prayers go out to his family and friends.

North Central District Health Department has sixteen cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

- **Henry County = 4**
 - 1 adult Caucasian male under medical care.
 - 2 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 adult Caucasian female under medical care.

- **Shelby County = 8**
 - 2 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
 - 3 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 pediatric Hispanic male in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 pediatric Hispanic female in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 pediatric Caucasian male in under medical care.

- **Spencer County= 4**
 - 1 pediatric Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 pediatric Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 adult Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 adult Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.

North Central District released fifty-one individuals from isolation; twenty-two from Shelby County, sixteen from Spencer County, one from Trimble County, and twelve from Henry County monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.
