North Central District Health Department regrettably announces two new deaths; one in Shelby County and one in Henry County both due to complications from the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). Forty new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby, Henry, Trimble, and Spencer Counties, increasing the district case count to 1236. Thirty-six individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.

Shelby County, KY – Shelby has had one new COVID-19 related death in an elderly female with underlying medical conditions; our hearts and prayers go out to her family and friends.

Henry County has had one new COVID-19 related death in an adult male with underlying medical conditions; our hearts and prayers go out to his family and friends.

North Central District Health Department has forty cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

- **Henry County = 7**
 - 1 adult Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
 - 3 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 adult African American male in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 adult African American female in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 pediatric Caucasian female under medical care.

- **Shelby County = 24**
 - 6 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
 - 10 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 adult African American male under medical care.
 - 1 adult Caucasian male under medical care.
 - 2 adult Hispanic males in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 pediatric Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 elderly Caucasian female under medical care.
 - 1 adult male unknown race and ethnicity in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 adult female unknown race and ethnicity in self-isolation at home.

- **Spencer County= 7**
 - 1 adult Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
 - 4 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.

North Central District released thirty-six individuals from isolation; fifteen from Shelby County, nine from Spencer County, and twelve from Henry County monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.

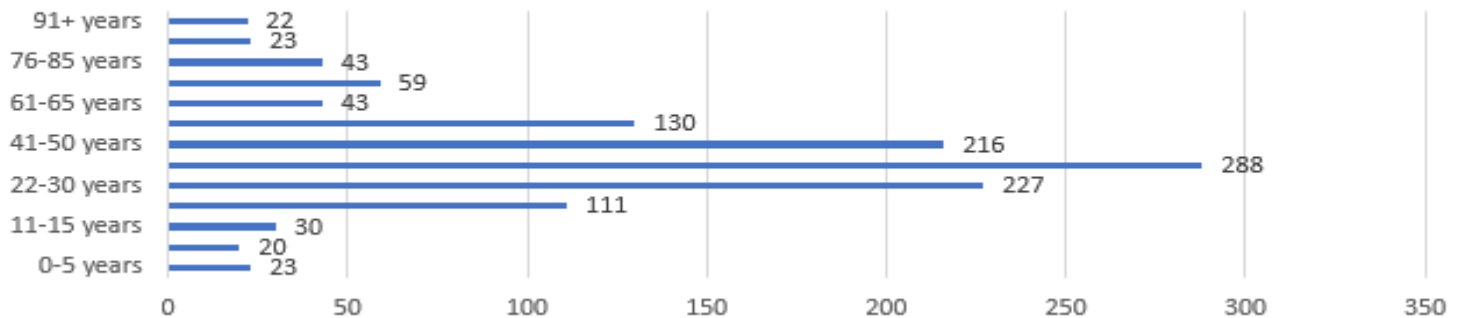
