North Central District Health Department is reporting thirty-seven new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby, Henry, Trimble, and Spencer Counties, increasing the district case count to 1273. Twenty-eight individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.

Shelby County, KY – North Central District Health Department has thirty-seven cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

- **Henry County = 5**
 - 2 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
 - 2 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 pediatric Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.

- **Shelby County = 25**
 - 5 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
 - 9 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
 - 4 adult African American females in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 adult Caucasian female under medical care.
 - 1 adult Hispanic male in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 adult Hispanic female in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 pediatric Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 pediatric African American male in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 pediatric African American female in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 pediatric Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.

- **Spencer County= 4**
 - 3 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 adult Caucasian male under medical care.

- **Trimble County= 3**
 - 2 adult Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 adult Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.

North Central District released twenty-eight individuals from isolation; sixteen from Shelby County, seven from Spencer County, one from Trimble County, and four from Henry County monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.
