North Central District Health Department is reporting twenty-five new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby, Henry, Trimble, and Spencer Counties, increasing the district case count to 1121. Thirteen individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.

Shelby County, KY – North Central District Health Department has twenty-five cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

- **Henry County = 7**
 - 5 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
 - 2 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.

- **Shelby County = 11**
 - 3 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 adult Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.
 - 2 adult African American males in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 adult Hispanic female in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 adult Hispanic female in under medical care.
 - 1 adult male in self-isolation at home. (Unknown race and ethnicity)
 - 1 adult Hispanic male in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 pediatric Hispanic female in self-isolation at home.

- **Spencer County= 6**
 - 5 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 adult female in self-isolation at home. (Unknown race and ethnicity)

- **Trimble County= 1**
 - 1 adult Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.

North Central District released thirteen individuals from isolation; nine from Shelby County, one from Spencer County, one from Trimble County, and two from Henry County monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.
