**North Central District Health Department is reporting sixty-seven new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby, Henry, Spencer, and Trimble Counties increasing the district case count to 784. Fourteen individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.**

**Shelby County, KY** – North Central District Health Department has sixty-seven cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

- **Henry County**
  - 1 adult Caucasian female under medical care.
  - 1 adult Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
- **Spencer County**
  - 3 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
  - 1 adult Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
  - 1 adult Hispanic female in self-isolation at home.
- **Trimble County**
  - 2 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
  - 1 adult Caucasian female in self-isolation at home
- **Shelby County**
  - 1 pediatric Hispanic female under medical care.
  - 2 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
  - 3 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
  - 1 adult Hispanic male in self-isolation at home.
  - 1 adult Hispanic female in self-isolation at home.
  - 49 adult females, unknown race/ethnicity at the Kentucky Correctional Institute for Women.

North Central District released fourteen individuals from isolation six from Shelby, two from Henry, three from Spencer, and three from Trimble Counties who monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.
