**North Central District Health Department regrettably announces two new deaths in Shelby County due to complications from the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). Fourteen new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby, Henry, Spencer, and Trimble Counties increasing the district case count to 556. Six individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.**

**Shelby County, KY** – Shelby has had two new COVID-19 related deaths in an elderly female and an elderly male with underlying medical conditions; our hearts and prayers go out to their families and friends.

North Central District Health Department has fourteen new cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

- **Henry County**
  - 1 adult Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.
- **Spencer County**
  - 1 adult Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
- **Trimble County**
  - 1 adult Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
- **Shelby County**
  - 2 pediatric Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
  - 1 pediatric Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.
  - 1 adult Hispanic female in self-isolation at home.
  - 2 adult Hispanic males in self-isolation at home.
  - 2 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
  - 2 elderly Caucasian females at Masonic Home of Shelbyville.
  - 1 adult Caucasian female at Masonic Home of Shelbyville.

North Central District released six individuals from isolation from Shelby County who monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.

“North Central District is working with the Department of Public Health and two congregate settings to mitigate the spread of the virus within those facilities”, said Roanya Rice, Public Health Director of NCDHD
