**North Central District Health Department is reporting twenty new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby, Henry, and Spencer Counties increasing the district case count to 967.**

**Shelby County, KY** – North Central District Health Department has twenty cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

- **Henry County = 4**
  - 2 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
  - 2 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
  
- **Spencer County = 7**
  - 3 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
  - 3 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
  - 1 pediatric Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
  
- **Trimble County = 1**
  - 1 adult Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
  
- **Shelby County= 8**
  - 3 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
  - 1 pediatric African American female in self-isolation at home.
  - 1 pediatric Hispanic male in self-isolation at home.
  - 2 adult Caucasian females under medical care.
  - 1 adult Caucasian female at the Kentucky Correctional Institute for Women.
