North Central District Health Department is reporting thirty-two new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby, Henry, Trimble, and Spencer Counties, increasing the district case count to 999. Nine of the new positive cases are from a congregate setting, Colonial Hall Manor, in Shelby County. Seventy-four individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.

Shelby County, KY – North Central District Health Department has thirty-two cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

- **Henry County = 8**
 - 6 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 adult Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 pediatric Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.
- **Spencer County = 7**
 - 5 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 adult Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 pediatric Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
- **Trimble County = 2**
 - 1 adult Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 pediatric Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.
- **Shelby County= 6**
 - 2 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 pediatric African American male in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 pediatric Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.
 - 2 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
- **Residence at Colonial Hall Manor= 9**
 - 5 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 adult African American male in self-isolation at home.
 - 2 pediatric Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 adult African American female in self-isolation at home.

North Central District released seventy-four individuals from isolation from forty-six from Shelby County, seventeen from Spencer County, five from Trimble County and six from Henry County who monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.
