North Central District Health Department regrettably announces three new deaths in Shelby County due to complications from the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). One hundred-ten new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby, Henry, Spencer, and Trimble Counties increasing the district case count to 666. Sixty-four individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.

Shelby County, KY – Shelby has had three new COVID-19 related deaths all in elderly females with underlying medical conditions; our hearts and prayers go out to their families and friends.

North Central District Health Department has one hundred-ten new cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

 - 1 pediatric Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 adult Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
- **Spencer County**
 - 1 adult Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
- **Trimble County**
 - 1 adult Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 pediatric Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
- **Shelby County**
 - 1 adult Caucasian female under medical care.
 - 1 adult Hispanic male in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 adult Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.
 - 2 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
 - 4 elderly Caucasian females at Masonic Home of Shelbyville.
 - 4 elderly Caucasian males at Masonic Home of Shelbyville.
 - 92 females, unknown race/ethnicity at the Kentucky Correctional Institute for Women.

North Central District released sixty-four individuals from isolation from sixty-two from Shelby County, one from Spencer County, and one from Henry County who monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.
