North Central District Health Department is reporting four new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby County, increasing the district case count to 222. Sixteen individuals monitored by North Central District has been released from isolation.

Shelby County, KY –North Central District Health Department has four new cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). All four are adult females from Shelby County, three in self-isolation at home and one under medical care; three cases are from the Hispanic population.

North Central District released sixteen individuals from isolation; thirteen from Shelby County, two from Spencer County, and one from Henry County who monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.

"As NCDHD wraps up its last two weeks of testing, I am encouraging everyone to get tested for COVID-19. NCDHD is now offering walk-up testing to accommodate those who would like to be tested but do not have transportation for the drive-thru testing. Appointments can be made for the drive-thru and walk-up testing by calling (502) 390-2600. We do not want transportation to be a barrier to getting tested.", said Roanya Rice, Public Health Director of NCDHD
