North Central District Health Department is reporting twenty-seven new lab-confirmed cases; twenty-six in Shelby County and one in Henry County, increasing the district case count to 319. Thirty-six individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.

Shelby County, KY –North Central District Health Department has twenty-seven new cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). Five Hispanic pediatric cases (four female and one male), eleven adult Hispanic males, seven adult Hispanic females, and three adult Caucasian males from Shelby County in self-isolation at home. One elderly Hispanic female from Henry County under medical care.

North Central District released thirty-six individuals from isolation; thirty-four from Shelby County, one from Henry County, and one from Spencer County; who monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.

"NCDHD has developed a partnership with Cumberland Family Medical Centers for COVID 19 testing at the Shelby County Health Department. Pre-registration is recommended by calling 888-674-0025; drive-thru testing is scheduled for Wednesday, June 17th from 10:00 am – 2:00 pm at 615 11th Street, Shelbyville, KY 40065. Testing will be available for anyone who resides or works in Shelby, Spencer, Henry, and Trimble County; additional dates may be forthcoming.”, said Roanya Rice, Public Health Director of NCDHD
