North Central District Health Department is reporting two new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby County, increasing the district case count to 224.

Shelby County, KY –North Central District Health Department has two new cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). Two adult males from Shelby County in self-isolation at home, both are from the Hispanic population.

"As NCDHD wraps up its last two weeks of testing, I am encouraging everyone to get tested for COVID-19. NCDHD is now offering walk-up testing to accommodate those who would like to be tested but do not have transportation for the drive-thru testing. Appointments can be made for the drive-thru and walk-up testing by calling (502) 390-2600. We do not want transportation to be a barrier to getting tested.", said Roanya Rice, Public Health Director of NCDHD
