North Central District Health Department regrettably announces the seventh death in Shelby County due to complications from the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). Twenty-nine new lab-confirmed cases, in Shelby, Henry, Spencer and Trimble Counties increasing the district case count to 462. Twenty-five individuals from Shelby County monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.

Shelby County, KY – Shelby has had its seventh COVID-19 related death in an elderly female with underlying medical conditions; our hearts and prayers go out to her family and friends.

North Central District Health Department has twenty-nine new cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

- **Henry County**
 - 1 adult Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 adult Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 adult Hispanic male in self-isolation at home.
- **Trimble County**
 - 1 adult Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
- **Spencer County**
 - 1 adult Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.
- **Shelby County**
 - 1 pediatric Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 adult Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
 - 11 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 adult Hispanic male in self-isolation at home.
 - 4 adult Hispanic females in self-isolation at home.
 - 6 females, unknown race/ethnicity at the Kentucky Correctional Institute for Women.

North Central District released twenty-five individuals from isolation from Shelby County, who monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.

“North Central District is working with the Department of Public Health and two congregate settings to mitigate the spread of the virus within those facilities”, said Roanya Rice, Public Health Director of NCDHD
