North Central District Health Department regrettfully announces the fifth death in Shelby County due to complications from the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). Four new lab-confirmed cases, three in Shelby County and one in Spencer County increasing the district case count to 228.

Shelby County, KY – Shelby has had its fifth COVID-19 related death in an adult Hispanic male, our hearts, and prayers go out to his family and friends.

North Central District Health Department has four new cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). Two Hispanic adult females, one adult Hispanic male from Shelby County, and one Caucasian female from Spencer County in self-isolation at home.

"NCDHD has one additional day of testing scheduled for 6/9/20. I am encouraging everyone to get tested for COVID-19. NCDHD is now offering walk-up testing to accommodate those who would like to be tested but do not have transportation for the drive-thru testing. Appointments can be made for the drive-thru and walk-up testing by calling (502) 390-2600. We do not want transportation to be a barrier to getting tested.", said Roanya Rice, Public Health Director of NCDHD
