North Central District Health Department is reporting thirty-four new lab-confirmed cases, thirty-two in Shelby County, and two in Henry County, increasing the district case count to 262. Seventeen individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.

Shelby County, KY –North Central District Health Department has thirty-four new cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). Eighteen adult females, fourteen adult males from Shelby County, and two adult males from Henry County all in self-isolation at home; twenty-nine cases are from the Hispanic population.

North Central District released seventeen individuals from isolation; sixteen from Shelby County and one from Henry County who monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.

"NCDHD has one additional day of testing scheduled for 6/9/20. I am encouraging everyone to get tested for COVID-19. NCDHD is now offering walk-up testing to accommodate those who would like to be tested but do not have transportation for the drive-thru testing. Appointments can be made for the drive-thru and walk-up testing by calling (502) 390-2600. We do not want transportation to be a barrier to getting tested.", said Roanya Rice, Public Health Director of NCDHD
