North Central District Health Department is reporting three new lab-confirmed cases, two in Shelby County and one in Spencer County; increasing the district case count to 268. Thirteen individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.

Shelby County, KY –North Central District Health Department has three new cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). Two adult Hispanic females from Shelby County, and one adult Caucasian female from Spencer County in self-isolation at home.

North Central District released Thirteen individuals from isolation; eleven from Shelby County and two from Henry County who monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.

"NCDHD has one additional day of testing scheduled for 6/9/20. I am encouraging everyone to get tested for COVID-19. NCDHD is now offering walk-up testing to accommodate those who would like to be tested but do not have transportation for the drive-thru testing. Appointments can be made for the drive-thru and walk-up testing by calling (502) 390-2600. We do not want transportation to be a barrier to getting tested.", said Roanya Rice, Public Health Director of NCDHD
