North Central District Health Department is reporting eight new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby County, increasing the district case count to 276.

Shelby County, KY –North Central District Health Department has eight new cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). Three adult Hispanic males, four adult Hispanic females, and one adult Caucasian male from Shelby County in self-isolation at home.

"NCDHD has one additional day of testing scheduled for 6/9/20. I am encouraging everyone to get tested for COVID-19. NCDHD is now offering walk-up testing to accommodate those who would like to be tested but do not have transportation for the drive-thru testing. Appointments can be made for the drive-thru and walk-up testing by calling (502) 390-2600. We do not want transportation to be a barrier to getting tested.", said Roanya Rice, Public Health Director of NCDHD
