North Central District Health Department is reporting three new lab-confirmed cases two in Shelby County and one in Henry County, increasing the district case count to 56.

Shelby County, KY – North Central District Health Department has three new cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). Two adult males from Shelby County one under medical care and the other in self-isolation at home; one adult male from Henry County in self-isolation at home.

“NCDHD will start providing COVID-19 testing on Tuesday, 5/5. Testing is by appointment only. You can make an appointment by calling NCDHD’s Call Center at 502-390-2600. I would encourage those who need it to be tested. Testing is an important component to help us get back to the new normal.”, said Roanya Rice, Public Health Director of NCDHD
