**North Central District Health Department is reporting two new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby County, increasing the district case count to 84. Seven individuals monitored by North Central District has been released from isolation.**

Shelby County, KY – North Central District Health Department has two new cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). An adult female in self-isolation at home and adult male under medical care from Shelby County.

North Central District released seven individuals from isolation, all from Shelby County who monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.

“As we continue to move through the phases of reopening, the importance of wearing a mask when not at home is even more critical for helping to prevent the spread of the virus. Everyone should be wearing a mask, as per the Governor’s order, and when they are not able to social distance.”, said Roanya Rice, Public Health
