North Central District Health Department is reporting eleven new lab-confirmed cases, ten in Shelby County and one in Henry County, increasing the district case count to 98. One individual monitored by North Central District has been released from isolation.

Shelby County, KY – North Central District Health Department has eleven new cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). Six adult males in self-isolation at home and four adult females in self-isolation at home from Shelby County and an adult male from Henry County in self-isolation at home.

North Central District released one individual from isolation from Shelby County who monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.

“As we continue to move through the phases of reopening, the importance of wearing a mask when not at home is even more critical for helping to prevent the spread of the virus. Everyone should be wearing a mask, as per the Governor’s order, and when they are not able to social distance.”, said Roanya Rice, Public Health Director of NCDHD
