North Central District Health Department is reporting seven new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby County, increasing the district case count to 105.

Shelby County, KY – North Central District Health Department has seven new cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). Four adult males and three adult females in self-isolation at home from Shelby County.

“As we continue to move through the phases of reopening, the importance of wearing a mask when not at home is even more critical for helping to prevent the spread of the virus. Everyone should be wearing a mask, as per the Governor’s order, and when they are not able to social distance.”, said Roanya Rice, Public Health Director of NCDHD
