North Central District Health Department is reporting five new lab-confirmed cases, four in Shelby County and one in Henry County, increasing the district case count to 114.

Shelby County, KY – North Central District Health Department has five new cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). Three adult males and one adult female in self-isolation at home from Shelby County. One elderly female under medical care from Henry County.

"NCDHD will continue to provide drive-thru testing for COVID-19 until the middle of June. Those who want to be tested should go ahead and call (502) 390-2600 to schedule an appointment. I encourage everyone to get tested.", said Roanya Rice, Public Health Director of NCDHD
