North Central District Health Department is reporting four new lab-confirmed cases, three in Shelby County and one in Trimble County, increasing the district case count to 119. One individual monitored by North Central District has been released from isolation.

Shelby County, KY – North Central District Health Department has four new cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). An adult female and two adult males from Shelby County all under medical care and one adult female from Trimble County.

North Central District released one individual from Shelby County from isolation who monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.

"I am encouraging everyone to get tested for COVID-19. NCDHD is now offering walk-up testing to accommodate those who would like to be tested but do not have transportation for the drive-thru testing. Appointments can be made for the drive-thru and walk-up testing by calling (502) 390-2600. We do not want transportation to be a barrier to getting tested.", said Roanya Rice, Public Health Director of NCDHD
