North Central District Health Department is reporting six new lab-confirmed cases, four in Shelby County and two in Henry County, increasing the district case count to 164.

Shelby County, KY –North Central District Health Department has six new cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). Two adult females and two adult males from Shelby County in self-isolation at home, an adult male and an adult female from Henry County in self-isolation at home.

"I am encouraging everyone to get tested for COVID-19. NCDHD is now offering walk-up testing to accommodate those who would like to be tested but do not have transportation for the drive-thru testing. Appointments can be made for the drive-thru and walk-up testing by calling (502) 390-2600. We do not want transportation to be a barrier to getting tested.", said Roanya Rice, Public Health Director of NCDHD
