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North Central District Health Department is reporting two new lab-confirmed cases; one in Shelby County and one in Henry County, increasing the district case count to 212.

Shelby County, KY –North Central District Health Department has two new cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). An adult Hispanic male from Shelby County in self-isolation at home and an elderly female that is a long-term care resident. North Central District Health Department is working with the facility to mitigate the spread of the virus.

"I am encouraging everyone to get tested for COVID-19. NCDHD is now offering walk-up testing to accommodate those who would like to be tested but do not have transportation for the drive-thru testing. Appointments can be made for the drive-thru and walk-up testing by calling (502) 390-2600. We do not want transportation to be a barrier to getting tested. Wearing a mask can dramatically reduce the risk of spreading the virus and possibly decrease the risk of you contracting the virus. The mask must be worn correctly to work; while wearing a mask it should fully cover your nose and mouth at all times", said Roanya Rice, Public Health Director of NCDHD
