North Central District Health Department is reporting one new lab-confirmed case in Spencer County, increasing the district case count to 60. One individual monitored by North Central District has been released from isolation.

Spencer County, KY – North Central District Health Department has one case that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). An adult female from Spencer County in self-isolation at home.

North Central District released one individual from isolation from Henry County who monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.

“NCDHD started providing COVID-19 testing today, 5/5/20. Testing in Shelby County will continue on Tuesdays. Testing will be available in Henry and Spencer Counties every Wednesday and Trimble on every Thursday from 10am-12pm, by appointment only.. You can make an appointment by calling NCDHD’s Call Center at 502-390-2600. I would encourage people to get tested. Testing is an important component to reopening the economy and helping us get back to the new normal.”, said Roanya Rice, Public Health Director of NCDHD
