**North Central District Health Department is reporting nine new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby County, increasing the district case count to 72.**

Shelby County, KY – North Central District Health Department has nine new cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). Four adult males and five adult females from Shelby County all in self-isolation at home.

“Now that NCDHD has started to provide COVID-19 testing in Shelby, Henry, Spencer, and Trimble Counties, it is likely that we will see the number of positive cases reported increase. The more you test the more likely you are to find positive cases. It is through testing that we can identify those who need to self-isolate and those actions help to reduce the spread of the virus, protecting the communities health at large. ”, said Roanya Rice, Public Health Director of NCDHD
