North Central District Health Department regrettably announces a new death from Shelby County due to complications from the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). Fifty-eight new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby, Henry, Trimble, and Spencer Counties, increasing the district case count to 1827. Thirty-four individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.

Shelby County, KY – Shelby County has had another COVID-19 related death in an elderly Hispanic female, with underlying medical conditions; our hearts and prayers go out to her family and friends.

North Central District Health Department has fifty-eight cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

 - 8 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.

- **Trimble County= 5**
 - 3 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
 - 2 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.

North Central District released thirty-four individuals from isolation; twenty-four from Shelby County, four from Spencer County, two from Trimble County, and four from Henry County monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.

“North Central District Health Department is now offering seasonal flu shots to our residence of Henry, Shelby, Spencer, and Trimble counties in our clinics. Everyone needs to receive the flu vaccine this year to prevent a conflict with the COVID-19 virus. Our clinics will be billing insurance, self-pay, or on a sliding scale based on income.”, said Roanya Rice, Public Health Director of NCDHD.
