North Central District Health Department is reporting sixty-two new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby, Henry, Trimble, and Spencer Counties, increasing the district case count to 1934. Twenty-seven individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.

Shelby County, KY – North Central District Health Department has sixty-two cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

 - 1 adult Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 adult Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.

North Central District released twenty-seven individuals from isolation; twenty from Shelby County, five from Spencer County, and two from Henry County monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.

“Over the last few weeks, the number of positive COVID 19 cases have been increasing at a greater rate than in the past, within the counties we serve. The increase within Shelby, Spencer, and Henry County is particularly alarming. The spread of the virus is not isolated to one area or type of person, it is community widespread. It is important to wear a mask, practice good social distancing, not only when working and shopping but particularly when participating in small group gatherings. These strategies are particularly important in small gatherings, as not wearing a mask and social distancing may be one of the major sources for the recent increase in positive cases. When the community does not consistently practice these measures, it can result in an escalation of positive cases that we are now seeing our counties.”, said Roanya Rice, Public Health Director of NCDHD.
