North Central District Health Department is reporting fourteen new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby, Trimble, and Spencer Counties, increasing the district case count to 1688. Four individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.

Shelby County, KY – North Central District Health Department has fourteen cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

- **Shelby County = 12**
 - 1 adult Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.
 - 3 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 elderly Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 adult Hispanic female in self-isolation at home.
 - 4 adult African American females in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 pediatric Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 pediatric African American male in self-isolation at home
- **Spencer County= 1**
 - 1 adult Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.
- **Trimble County= 1**
 - 1 elderly Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.

North Central District released four individuals from isolation; three from Shelby County and one from Trimble County monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.

“With the start of most schools with in-person classes, it will take a community-wide effort to maintain in-person classes. If everyone practices good social distancing, limits group size, properly wears a mask and sanitizes appropriately we can keep the 7-day COVID-19 case incident rate low and our counties out of the Red Zone. It is also important for everyone to get a flu shot this year. You can go to NCDHD’s website to see the schedule for free drive-thru flu clinics over the next 2-weeks.”, said Roanya Rice, Public Health Director of NCDHD.
