North Central District Health Department is reporting thirty-seven new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby, Henry, and Spencer Counties, increasing the district case count to 1992. Fifty-one individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.

Shelby County, KY – North Central District Health Department has thirty-seven cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

- **Shelby County = 27**
 - 8 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
 - 6 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
 - 2 elderly Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 pediatric Hispanic female in self-isolation at home.
 - 5 adult Hispanic male in self-isolation at home.
 - 3 adult Hispanic females in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 adult African American male in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 elderly Hispanic female in self-isolation at home.
- **Henry County= 8**
 - 2 adult Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
 - 4 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 elderly Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 elderly Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
- **Spencer County= 2**
 - 1 adult Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 adult Caucasian male under medical care.

North Central District released fifty-one individuals from isolation; thirty-two from Shelby County, twelve from Spencer County, four from Henry County, and three from Spencer County monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.

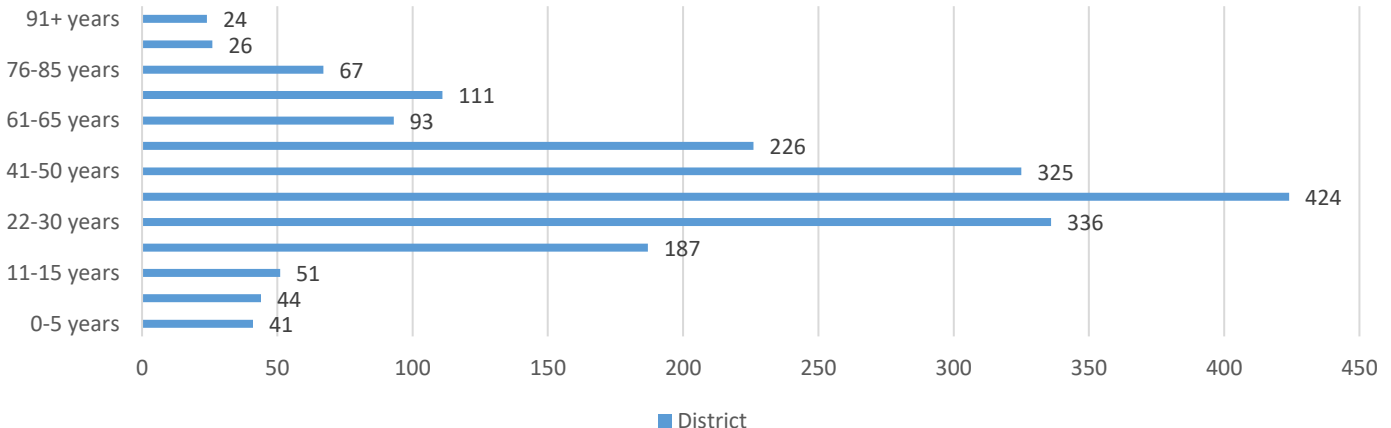

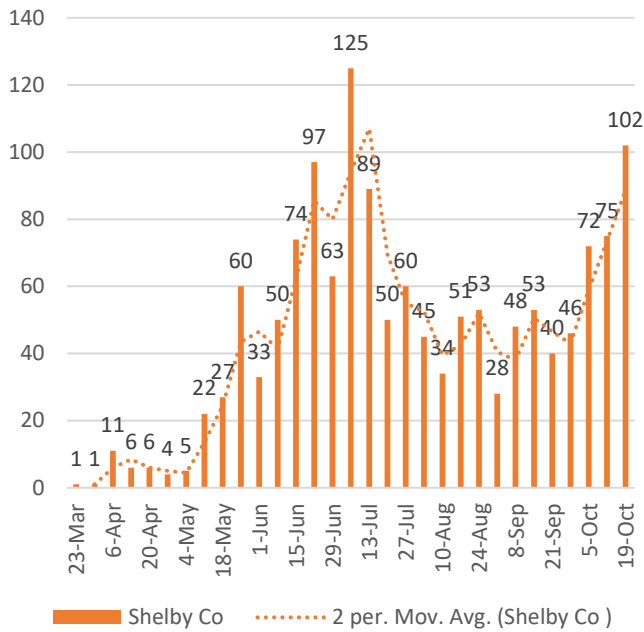

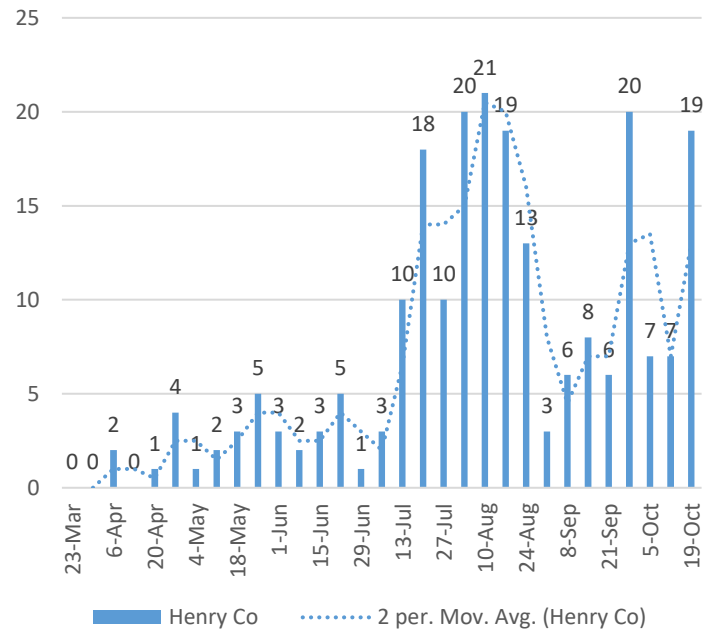

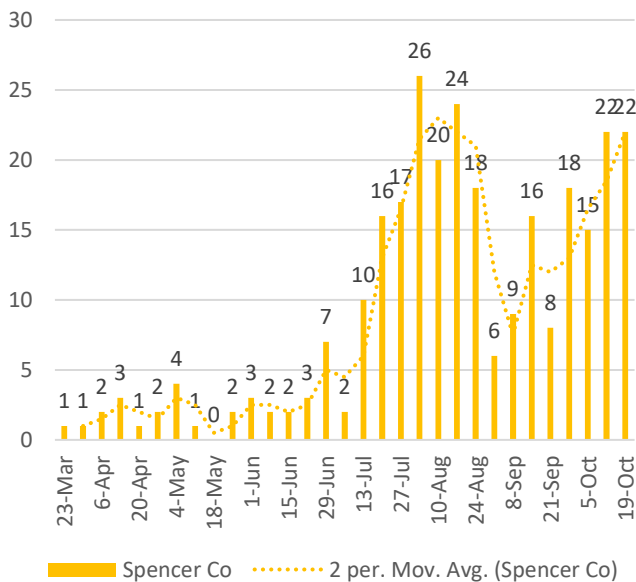
Shelby County Cases by Week



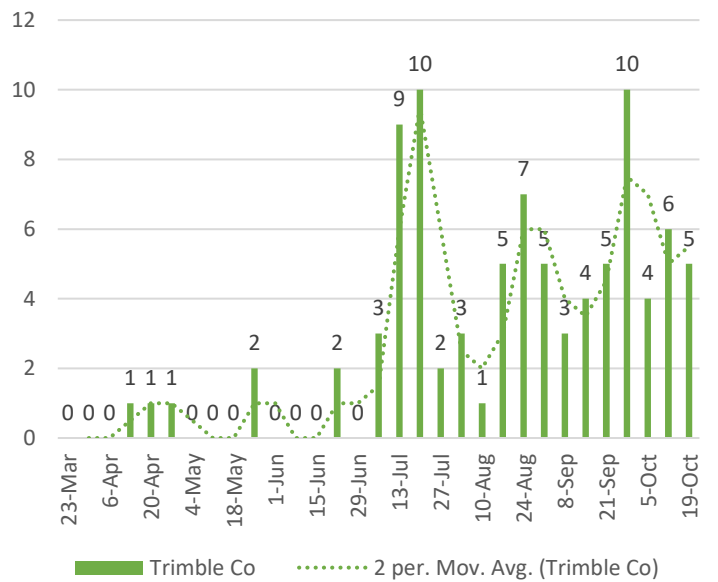
Henry County Cases by Week
