North Central District Health Department regretfully announces a new death from Spencer County due to complications from the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) and its highest positive case count for this reporting period. One hundred-seven new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby, Henry, Trimble, and Spencer Counties, increasing the district case count to 2099. Forty-four individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.

Shelby County, KY – Spencer County has had its third COVID-19 related death in an elderly Caucasian male, with underlying medical conditions; our hearts and prayers go out to his family and friends.

North Central District Health Department has one hundred-seven cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

- **Trimble County= 4**
 - 2 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 adult Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 pediatric Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.

North Central District released forty-four individuals from isolation; twenty-seven from Shelby County, eight from Spencer County, eight from Henry County, and one from Trimble County monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.

“North Central District is experiencing our highest daily totals of Covid-19 positive cases to date. With the counties displaying higher levels of positive Covid-19 cases with community-wide spread, increasing Covid testing of community members and contact tracing all confirmed positives is essential to protect our citizens. Community-wide masking compliance, social distancing, and proper hygiene are the most effective factors in reducing the total positive cases. COVID testing is available at NCDHD’s clinic locations in Henry, Shelby, Spencer, and Trimble counties. I urge community members to wear a mask even when gathering in small groups and with your inner circles outside of your immediate family. This is the strategy that can have the greatest impact on slowing the spread of the virus as we are clearly in an escalation”, said Roanya Rice, Public Health Director of NCDHD.

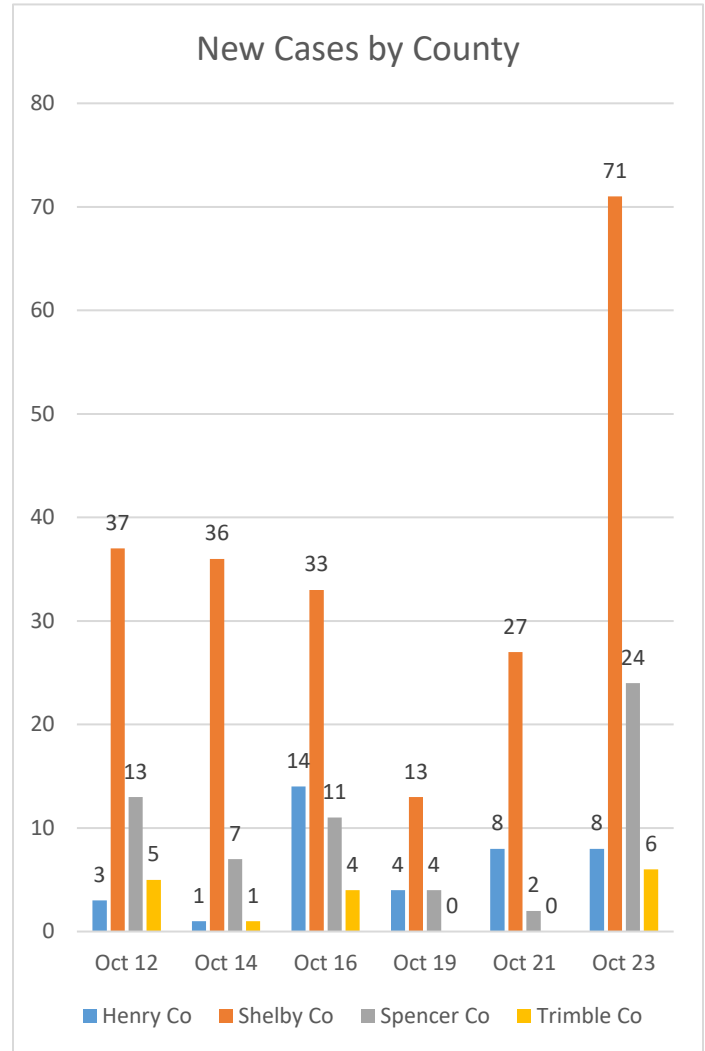
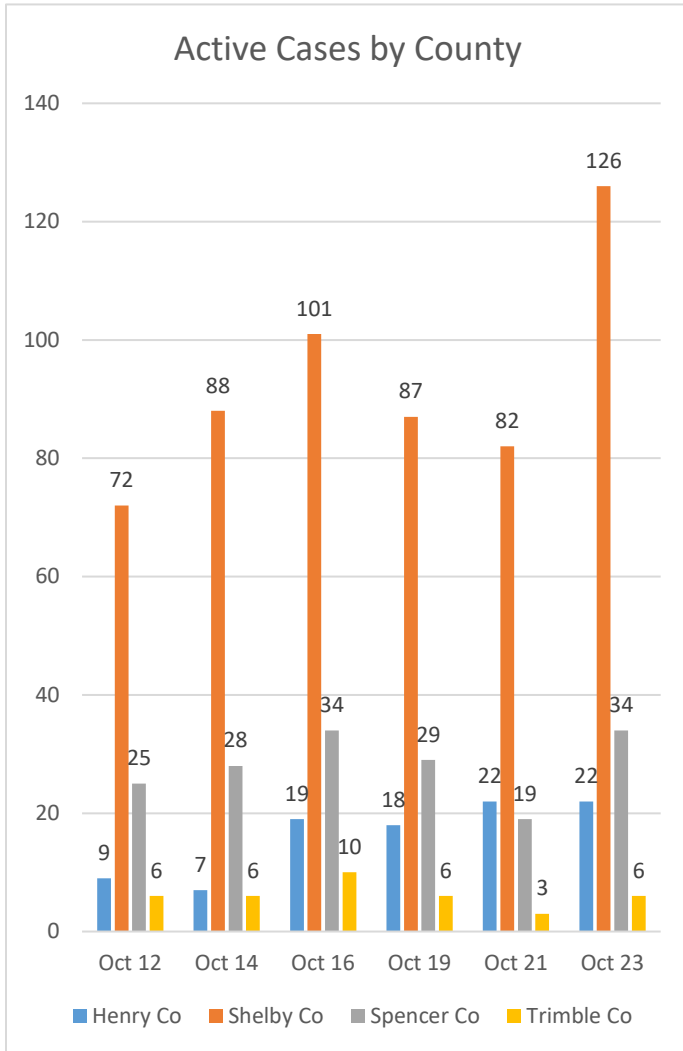
