**North Central District Health Department is reporting forty-six new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby, Henry, Trimble, and Spencer Counties, increasing the district case count to 2214. Forty-seven individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.**

**Shelby County, KY** –North Central District Health Department has forty-six cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

- **Shelby County = 24**
  - 5 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
  - 8 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
  - 2 elderly Caucasian males under medical care.
  - 3 elderly Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
  - 2 adult Hispanic females in self-isolation at home.
  - 1 adult Hispanic male in self-isolation at home.
  - 1 adult Hispanic female under medical care.
  - 1 pediatric African American male in self-isolation at home.
  - 1 pediatric African American female in self-isolation at home.
  
- **Henry County= 12**
  - 1 adult Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
  - 3 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
  - 2 elderly Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
  - 1 elderly Caucasian male in self-isolation at home
  - 2 pediatric Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
  - 2 pediatric Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
  - 1 elderly African American male under medical care.
  
- **Spencer County= 9**
  - 5 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
  - 4 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
  
- **Trimble County= 1**
  - 1 elderly Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.

North Central District released forty-seven individuals from isolation; twenty-eight from Shelby County, five from Spencer County, twelve from Henry County, and two from Trimble County monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.

*“North Central District is experiencing high daily totals of Covid-19 positive cases. With 3 out of 4 of our counties displaying higher levels of positive Covid-19 cases with community-wide spread. Increasing Covid testing of community members and contact tracing all confirmed positives is essential to protect our citizens. Community-wide masking compliance, social distancing, and proper hygiene are the most effective factors in reducing the total positive cases. COVID 19 testing is available at NCDHD’s clinic locations in Henry, Shelby, Spencer, and Trimble counties. I urge community members to wear a mask even when gathering in small groups and with your inner circles outside of your immediate family. This is the strategy that can have the greatest impact on slowing the spread of the virus as we are clearly in an escalation”, said Roanya Rice, Public Health Director of NCDHD.*
