North Central District Health Department regrettably announces two deaths, one from Shelby County and one from Spencer County due to complications from the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). Twenty-three new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby, Henry, Trimble, and Spencer Counties, increasing the district case count to 1769. Twenty-seven individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.

Shelby County, KY – Shelby County has had another COVID-19 related death in an elderly Caucasian female, with underlying medical conditions; our hearts and prayers go out to her family and friends.

Spencer County has had its second COVID-19 related death in an adult Caucasian male, with underlying medical conditions; our hearts and prayers go out to his family and friends.

North Central District Health Department has twenty-three cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

- **Shelby County = 15**
 - 5 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
 - 3 elderly Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 adult Caucasian female under medical care.
 - 1 pediatric Hispanic female in self-isolation at home.
 - 2 pediatric Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 elderly African American female under medical care.
 - 1 elderly Caucasian female under medical care.
 - 1 adult African American female in self-isolation at home.
- **Henry County= 3**
 - 3 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
- **Spencer County= 4**
 - 2 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
 - 2 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
- **Trimble County= 1**
 - 1 elderly Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.

North Central District released thirty-seven individuals from isolation; twenty-two from Shelby County, two from Spencer County, and three from Henry County monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.

“During the 2019-2020 influenza season, CDC estimates that influenza in the United States was associated with 38 million illnesses, 18 million medical visits, 405,000 hospitalizations, and 22,000 deaths; receiving your flu vaccination, wearing a mask, and proper handwashing will be necessary to help fight off the Covid-19 and flu virus.

North Central District Health Department will be providing free flu shots at an upcoming drive-thru clinic at Shelby County Health Department on Saturday- October 10 from 9:30 am- 12:30 pm.”, said Roanya Rice, Public Health Director of NCDHD.
