**North Central District Health Department is reporting twenty-four new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby, Spencer, and Henry Counties, increasing the district case count to 1480. Sixteen individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.**

**Shelby County, KY** – North Central District Health Department has twenty-four cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

- **Henry County = 4**
  - 3 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
  - 1 adult Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
  
- **Shelby County = 13**
  - 5 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
  - 2 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
  - 3 adult Hispanic females in self-isolation at home.
  - 1 elderly Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.
  - 1 pediatric Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
  - 1 adult Caucasian male under medical care.
  
- **Spencer County= 7**
  - 1 adult Caucasian female under medical care.
  - 4 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
  - 1 pediatric Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
  - 1 adult Caucasian male under medical care.

North Central District released sixteen individuals from isolation; three from Shelby County, five from Spencer County, one from Trimble County, and seven from Henry County monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.
