**North Central District Health Department is reporting fifteen new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby and Spencer Counties, increasing the district case count to 1495. Ten individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.**

**Shelby County, KY** – North Central District Health Department has fifteen cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

- **Shelby County = 11**
  - 5 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
  - 1 adult Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
  - 2 adult Hispanic females in self-isolation at home.
  - 1 adult Hispanic male in self-isolation at home.
  - 1 pediatric African American male in self-isolation at home.
  - 1 pediatric African American female in self-isolation at home.
  
- **Spencer County= 4**
  - 3 adult Caucasian females under medical care.
  - 1 adult Hispanic male in self-isolation at home.

North Central District released ten individuals from isolation; nine from Shelby County and one from Trimble County monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.
