North Central District Health Department is reporting thirty new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby, Henry, Trimble, and Spencer Counties, increasing the district case count to 1546. Eighteen individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.

Shelby County, KY – North Central District Health Department has thirty cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

- **Shelby County = 18**
 - 8 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
 - 5 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 adult Hispanic female in self-isolation at home.
 - 3 adult Hispanic males in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 pediatric Hispanic female in self-isolation at home.
- **Spencer County= 3**
 - 1 adult Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 Hispanic female in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 pediatric Hispanic female in self-isolation at home.
- **Henry County= 5**
 - 2 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
 - 3 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
- **Trimble County= 4**
 - 2 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 adult Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 elderly female resident at the Bedford Springs Health and Rehabilitation.

North Central District released eighteen individuals from isolation; eleven from Shelby County and seven from Spencer County monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.

“North Central District Health Department will be conducting free flu clinics in October for the public to prevent a possible double infection from the flu and COVID-19.
