North Central District Health Department regrettably announces the first death in Spencer County due to complications from the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). Twenty-two new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby, Henry, Trimble, and Spencer Counties, increasing the district case count to 1648. Twenty-nine individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.

Shelby County, KY – Spencer has had its first COVID-19 related death in an adult Caucasian male, with underlying medical conditions; our hearts and prayers go out to his family and friends.

North Central District Health Department has twenty-two cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

- **Shelby County = 8**
 - 4 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 adult Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 pediatric Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 elderly Caucasian female under medical care.
 - 1 adult Hispanic female under medical care.
- **Spencer County= 3**
 - 1 adult Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 adult Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 pediatric Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.
- **Henry County= 8**
 - 5 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
 - 2 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home
 - 1 adult African American male in self-isolation at home.
- **Trimble County= 3**
 - 1 pediatric Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 adult Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 elderly Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.

North Central District released twenty-nine individuals from isolation; fifteen from Shelby County, five from Henry County, three from Trimble County, and six from Spencer County monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.
