**North Central District Health Department regrettably announces the fourth death in Henry County due to complications from the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). Twenty-six new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby, Henry, Trimble, and Spencer Counties, increasing the district case count to 1674. Thirty-one individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.**

**Shelby County, KY** – Henry County has had its fourth COVID-19 related death in an adult Caucasian female, with underlying medical conditions; our hearts and prayers go out to her family and friends.

North Central District Health Department has twenty-six cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

- **Shelby County = 19**
  - 4 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
  - 5 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
  - 2 elderly Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
  - 1 adult Hispanic male in self-isolation at home.
  - 1 adult Hispanic female in self-isolation at home.
  - 1 elderly Hispanic female under medical care.
  - 1 adult African American female in self-isolation at home.
  - 1 pediatric Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
  - 2 pediatric Caucasian females in self-isolation at home
  - 1 pediatric Hispanic female in self-isolation at home.
- **Spencer County= 5**
  - 1 adult Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.
  - 3 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
  - 1 pediatric Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
- **Henry County= 1**
  - 1 pediatric Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
- **Trimble County= 1**
  - 1 adult Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.

North Central District released thirty-one individuals from isolation; twenty-one from Shelby County, seven from Henry County, two from Trimble County, and one from Spencer County monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.
