North Central District Health Department regretfully announces one new death in Shelby County due to complications from the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). Forty-two new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby, Spencer, Trimble, and Henry Counties, increasing the district case count to 1456. Forty individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.

Shelby County, KY – Shelby has had one new COVID-19 related death in an adult female with underlying medical conditions; our hearts and prayers go out to her family and friends.

North Central District Health Department has forty-two cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

- **Henry County = 5**
 - 2 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 adult Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 pediatric Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 elderly Caucasian female under medical care.
- **Shelby County = 27**
 - 8 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
 - 10 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
 - 3 adult Hispanic males in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 adult Hispanic female in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 elderly Caucasian male under medical care.
 - 1 pediatric Asian male in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 elderly Hispanic male under medical care.
 - 1 pediatric Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 pediatric Hispanic female in self-isolation at home.
- **Spencer County= 7**
 - 1 adult Caucasian female under medical care.
 - 6 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
- **Trimble County= 3**
 - 3 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.

North Central District released forty individuals from isolation; twenty-eight from Shelby County, six from Spencer County, five from Trimble County, and one from Henry County monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.

***Due to the holiday this release is reflective of a 5-day reporting period case total. Therefore, the numbers may be higher.**

“I highly recommend that everyone get a flu shot this year. It is always important to do so, but even more urgent this year because the symptoms for COVID and the flu are similar. Contracting COVID 19 and the flu at the same time could be catastrophic to your health, said Roanya Rice, Public Health Director of NCDHD.
