North Central District Health Department is reporting eighty-one new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby, Henry, Spencer, and Trimble Counties, increasing the district case count to 8,168. Eighty-eight individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.

Shelby County, KY – North Central District Health Department has eighty-one cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

North Central District released eighty-eight individuals from isolation; thirty-nine from Shelby County, twenty-three from Spencer County, sixteen from Henry County and ten from Trimble County monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.

North Central District Health Department regretfully is announcing multiple deaths from the state’s COVID 19 death audit report; this information dates back to Fall/Winter of 2020. The Kentucky state COVID 19 death audit report has identified ten people who lived in the areas North Central District Health Department serve; seven in Shelby County, two in Spencer County, and one from Trimble County due to complications from the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

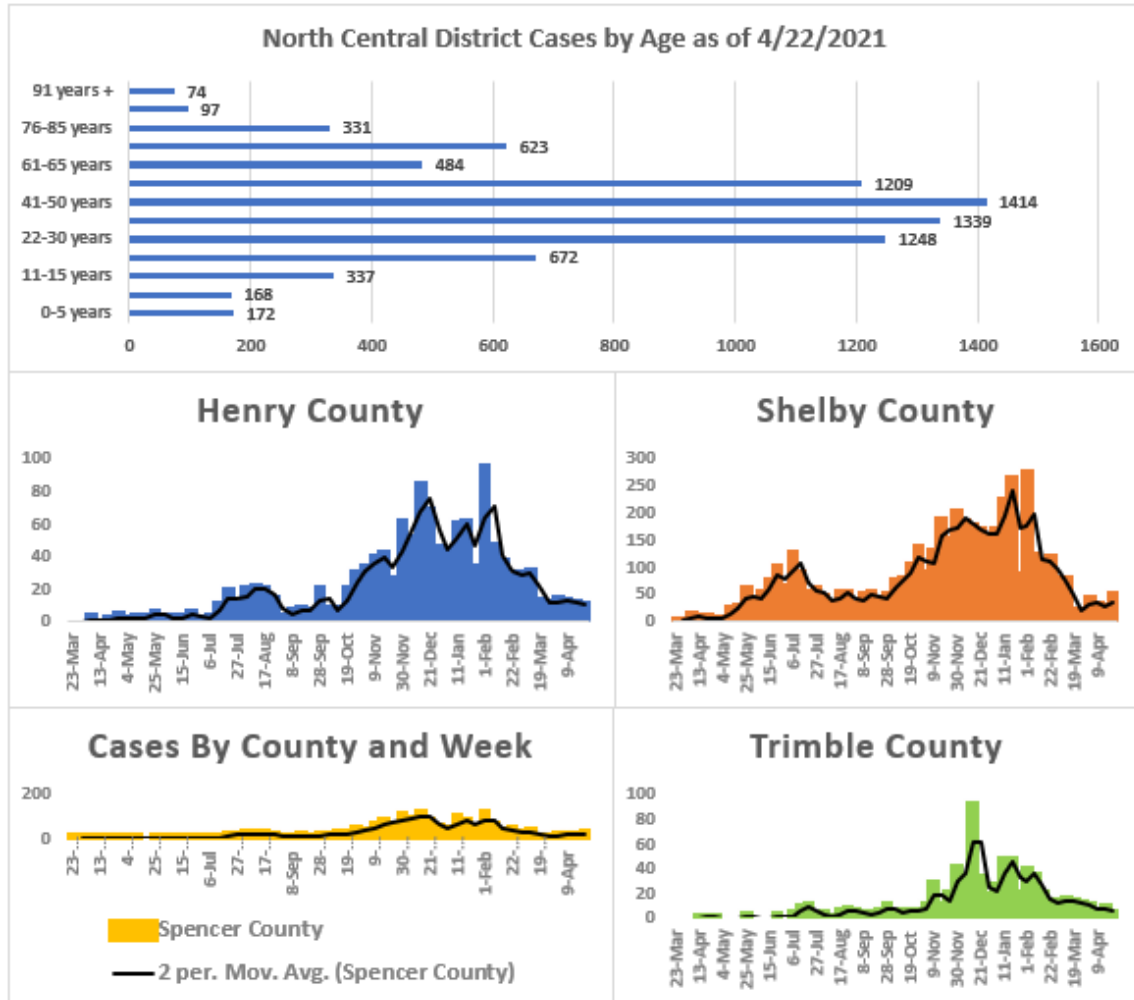
