North Central District Health Department regretfully is announcing a new death in Henry County due to complications from the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). One hundred-three new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby, Henry, Spencer, and Trimble Counties, increasing the district case count to 8,271. Seventy-five individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.

Shelby County, KY – Henry County has had a COVID-19 related death in an elderly Caucasian male with underlying conditions; our hearts and prayers go out to his family and friends.

North Central District Health Department has one hundred-three cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

North Central District released seventy-five individuals from isolation; forty from Shelby County, twenty-one from Spencer County, nine from Henry County and five from Trimble County monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.

***Due to external data reporting delay, our total cases reported has been elevated.**

The Kentucky state COVID 19 death audit report has identified three people who lived in the areas North Central District Health Department serve all three in Spencer County due to complications from the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

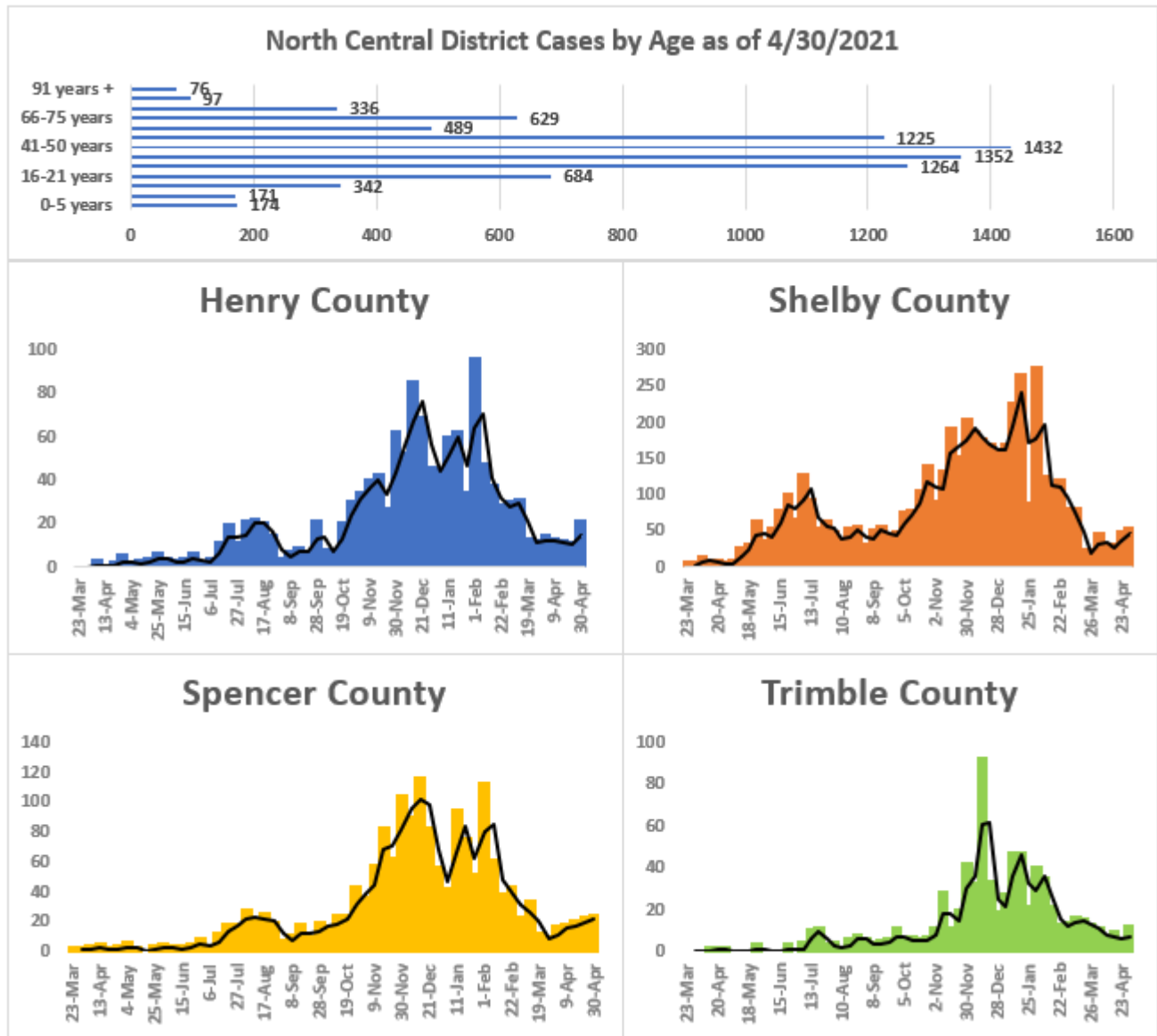
