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North Central District Health Department is reporting ninety-nine new lab-confirmed cases in Shelby, Henry, Trimble, and Spencer Counties, increasing the district case count to 4477. Ninety-eight individuals monitored by North Central District have been released from isolation.

Shelby County, KY – North Central District Health Department has ninety-nine cases that tested positive for the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19).

 - 21 adult Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
 - 12 adult Caucasian males in self-isolation at home.
 - 4 elderly Caucasian females in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 elderly Caucasian male in self-isolation at home.

 - 1 pediatric Caucasian female in self-isolation at home.
 - 1 adult African American female in self-isolation at home.
 - 4 adult African American males in self-isolation at home.

North Central District released ninety-eight individuals from isolation; twenty-four from Shelby County, twenty-five from Spencer County, twenty-one from Trimble County, and twenty-eight from Henry County monitored their symptoms and complied with a self-isolation agreement with the Health Department.
